ARTIST STATEMENT

The process of creating an art work is my way to interpret the life of humanity, the value of humanity and the identity of people. Since the initial contact with photography, I found out that the medium's great pliability is perfect for creative expressions. Portrait used to be my major work. Through portraits, I can express people's longing, pursuit and the relationships between humans, nature and society, cognition and perception. Recently, I inspired by my curiosity about things around me, not underestimating the daily life seems to be nothing. Everyone is composed of daily life. It is not ordinary. I started to photography the city where I am living and my daily life. I started to pay more attention to the tensility and atmosphere of my life.

Through the glass objects, I photographed a series of portra its. Through the refraction of light, I tried to show a surreal shape. This project wants to express the human soul behind the surface. When we lose the false shells of the body, the real and surreal souls are starting to be found.







My project develops through three different languages: Photography and painting literature.Six different stories are related to different characters. Observing hidden elements of the life of some characters dear to me, I wanted to bring out their desires, their passions and their loves.I wrote six stories like this. I wanted to evoke and not to illustrate.

In some portraits, I have used digital processing tools to create the photomontages and portraits for all of them, finally they are intervened by inserting the color with a pictorial gesture.

"I paint what cannot be photographed, that which comes from the dreams, from the imagination or from an unconscious drive. I photograph the things I don't want to paint, the things that already have their existence "(Man Ray.)

The use of color is intended to evoke the hid den part, the story and the aura of the character, representing the connection between his inner world and the space depicted. In other words, the visible part of the image is a metaphor of the body in space, while the color is an attempt to metaphorically express the perception of the character which is related to the planet.







CITY AND UTOPIA MY MEMORIAL LOCATION
















CITY AND UTOPIA MY PLACE OF WORK

In 2017-2018, I lived in Beijing for one year. My working environment and living environment are full of Beijing city characteristics, which makes me set the lens in urban space, giving them multiple meanings. I am working on several projects to express the complex big cities in my eyes, among which are the dystopia representatives of large buildings and urban spaces.

I didn't work in a location like "Beijing" city, but I was working near the coking station at the end of the Beijing Metro Line 7 at the east end. What is interesting is that there is a huge abandoned coking factory near the office. In the ruin area, except for the big trucks, the loess dust, the industrial sites and the group of construction workers, we are the only modern office building. Every day we wear professional clothes and walk through a large abandoned factory to the office. This huge contrast has caused me a lot of curiosity about this area.

The coking factory was built in 1958 for environmental protection. Before 2008, it was stopped by environmental protection. It carried the glorious and tragic history of Chinese industry. It transports commercial gas to reduce the amount of coal burned, but he also contributed to the Beijing smog.


CITY AND UTOPIA MY PLACE OF LIFE

In March 2019, I went to Beijing for three weeks to work. Work was transfe rred from the coking plant in the suburbs to the Central Business District (CBD) in Beijing. Due to the cheap rent and excellent location, I chose the residential area of the CBD. - Huashi camp. It attracts poor street vendors and many office workers who work in near by office buildings, they walked on the floor of the clean central business district in high heels during the day. In the evening, they returned to the Huashi camp and fell asleep in the ten-square-meter hut. Some indigenous people who have nowhere to go must stay here.


Perhaps all those who have seen Huashi camps in the CBD of Beijing will express a question in their hearts. "There is such a place at the foot of the Beijing CBD?"

Indeed, from the H port of the Hujialou metro station, which is about 500 meters away, you will see a group of low and dilapidated spires. After more than 60 years of wind and rain, bare cement or red bricks are posted with small advertisements everywhere.

This is the last village in the Beijing CBD. Opposite Chaoyangmenwai Street, there is a group of Utopia buildings, such as Beijing Fortune Center, World Financial Center, Wantong Center, Chaowai SOHO and other high-end office buildings. There is also the highest building in Beijing in the southeast. In the sun, standing on the street of the Huashi camp, looking south, the glass curtain wall of the high-rise building reflects the brilliant light, and the prosperity and the ruin of the side seem to become unreal. I huddled in the front and back of Utopia, moving back and forth between the affluent areas of Beijing and the slums of Beijing.














Real Life How social network influence a city

Can we feel or discover the beauty of visiting places when we have no goals, no media recommendations, and follow our hearts to see, hear, listen, stop and reflect?


Is it better to travel without a social network? Looking at everything with a fresh point of view.


